Smooth and juicy Carmenere brimming with blackberries, spicy damsons, pepper and a hint of chocolate.
- 34 Montepulciano d'Abruzzo "Jorio" 2006, Umani Ronchi, Italy 29.95
Deeply satisfying red from central Italy, warm & spicy with soft, ripe tannins & a twist of bitter cherries.
- 35 Simonsig Estate Pinotage 2005/6, Stellenbosch, S. Africa 28.50
Made in the traditional, unoaked style, a juicy, up-front Pinotage packed with mellow, jammy fruit.
- 36 Côtes du Rhône, 2008, Domaine de la Janasse, Rhône Valley, France 26.95
One of Robert Parker's stars, Janasse take as much care with their Côtes-du-Rhone as they do with their Châteauneuf-du-Pape - rich, spicy and substantial.
- 37 Merlot "Rosso Rosso" 2005/06, DOC Colli Orientali del Friuli, Italy 26.95
A super elegant Merlot from the cool hills of Northern Italy – soft black fruits, a finely structured palate and a long, vanilla-cocoa finish.
- 38 Morgon, Domaine Ferraud, 'Les Charmes' 2007, Pierre Ferraud, Beaujolais, France 29.50
One of the more full bodied of the Beaujolais Crus, this soft red is full of fresh, juicy ripe red berry and cherry flavours, given structure by fresh acidity and spicy tannins.
- 39 Anthony's Reserve Shiraz 2002, Simon Hackett, McLaren Vale, South Australia 43.95
Named by Simon Hackett in honour of his brother, this spicy, peppery red opens into a lush, sweet-berried palate. Highly rated by wine guru Robert Parker.
- 40 Pinot Noir 2007, Tindall Estate, Marlborough, New Zealand 32.50
Light, juicy Pinot Noir brimming with luscious strawberry and plum flavours, with smoky nuances.
- 41 Gevrey-Chambertin 2006, "Vieilles Vignes", Domaine Jean-Phillipe Marchand 62.95
A wickedly silky and rich Pinot Noir from the Cotes-du-Nuits, light ruby in colour with aromatic raspberry flavours.
- 42 Estate Cabernet Sauvignon 1993, Durney Vineyards, Carmel Valley, California 36.95
A stunning organic California Cabernet, with a finely judged balance of ripe fruit, toasty oak and firm tannin.
- 43 Côte Rôtie 2000, Chateau Saint Cosme, Rhône Valley 79.95
Made predominantly from the Syrah grape, Côte-Rôtie contains a small amount of white Viognier, adding a layer of exotic complexity not found in other red wines from the northern Rhône. Raspberry, mulberry and vanilla aromas, a harmonious balance between imperceptible acidity and firm tannins.
- 44 Amarone della Valpolicella Classico 2005, Luigi Righetti, Veneto, Italy 42.95
Not for the faint hearted, 'Amarone' literally means 'big, bitter one', a reference to the rich, plummy flavours of this Italian classic with its undertones of dark chocolate & bitter cherries
- 45 Château Kirwan 1998, 3ème Cru Classé Margaux 94.50
Seductive Margaux from Kirwan – masters of the elegant, concentrated style of the appellation. Black fruits and cedar notes mix with an attractive, nutty character. Complex fruit flavours and firm tannins.

46	Barolo "Vigna la Rosa" 2001, Fontanafredda, Piemonte, Italy <i>One of several wines termed "the wine of kings, the king of wines", Barolo is uniquely known as "wine of tar and roses", both to be found in the aroma, along with plums and liquorice. A huge wine, with rich tannins, long, chewy flavours and alcoholic warmth.</i>	83.50
